Agniveer Navy MR eligibility criteria

agniveer navy mr educational qualification:

To qualify for Navy MR Recruitment 2023, candidates must have satisfactorily passed the Matriculation Examination from boards of school education that hold recognition from the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

The shortlisting process will be conducted state-wise, with a ratio of four times the number of vacancies. It's important to note that the cut-off marks may differ from state to state.

Candidates who are shortlisted will receive a call-up letter for the written examination and Physical Fitness Test (PFT). It is mandatory for candidates to have an Aadhar Card for the written examination and PFT.

agniveer navy mr exam pattern

The examination pattern for Indian Navy MR is as follows:

- (a) The question paper will be conducted in a computer-based format and will consist of a total of 50 questions, with each question carrying 1 mark.
- (b) The question paper will be available in both Hindi and English languages, and it will be of objective type, with multiple-choice questions.

- (c) The question paper will be divided into two sections: Science & Mathematics and General Awareness.
- (d) The question paper will be based on the syllabus covered in the 10th standard, ensuring it aligns with that level of knowledge and understanding.

For Agniveer (MR) - both male and female candidates, the merit list will be prepared on an all India basis. The merit list will be made available on the website https://agniveernavy.cdac.in by October 23.

For Agniveer (MR) - male candidates, the merit list will be based on state-wise merit. The cut-off marks for receiving the call-up letter for the Recruitment Medical Examination at INS Chilka may vary from state to state.

For Agniveer (MR) - female candidates, the merit list will be based on all India merit. In the event of candidates securing similar cut-off marks in the Written Examination, the candidate with a higher percentage in the qualifying examination (10th) will be selected for the Recruitment Medical Examination at INS Chilka.
